How do I join the Legion? Am I eligible?

To be a member of the American Legion, you must have served at least one day of active duty during a time of conflict, which are:

*April 6, 1917 to November 11, 1918
December 7, 1941 to December 31, 1946
June 25, 1950 to January 31, 1955
February 28, 1961 to May 7, 1975
August 24, 1982 to July 31, 1984
December 20, 1989 to January 31, 1990
August 2, 1990 to today*

To join the Sons of the American Legion, you must be a male descendant of a Legion member. You are also eligible to join the SAL if you're a male descendant of a veteran who died in a conflict, or was honorably discharged after serving in a conflict and has passed away.

Women who are eligible for membership in the Legion are also eligible to belong to the Legion Auxiliary, as are women who are directly related to a member of the American Legion.

These are the basics. We encourage you to do a bit of research on your own to make sure you're eligible - you might have to track down your DD214 (they have copies at the courthouse if you can't find yours).

What's this "Business Supporter" thing?

Simple - if you own a business you can be a Business Supporter and help finance the ALR for \$50 a year, regardless of military experience. It's a good thing to do if you can. We promise to use the money for good.

What is the ALR?

The Northwest Iowa chapter of the American Legion Riders, based out of American Legion's Wasmer Post 241 in LeMars, Iowa, is one of Iowa's fastest growing chapters with over 75 members to date.

To quote the national ALR web site: "The American Legion Riders are members of the American Legion who are also motorcycle enthusiasts. They can be found participating in parades, partaking in motorcycling events, and supporting the communities in which they live, work, and play. Members of the ALR come from the Legion, the Legion Auxillary, and the Sons of the American Legion. The ALR is not a motorcycle club, and does not practice motorcycle club rules or regulations. The ALR is family-oriented, just as is its parent organization, the American Legion."

Who can join?

To be a member of the ALR, you must be a current member in good standing of the American Legion, American Legion Auxiliary, or Sons of the American Legion, and own a motorcycle of at least 350cc displacement complete with a valid driver's license. (Married couples don't both need to own bikes, as long as one of 'em is eligible and one of 'em owns a bike they can both be in the ALR.)
